

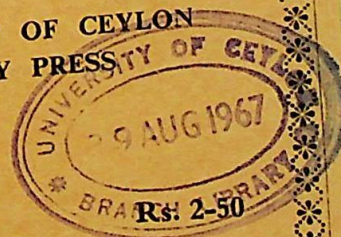
UNIVERSITY OF CEYLON REVIEW
